Dear Mr. Tambo

As an ex-South African Dutch citizen, I can fully understand and appreciate the S.A. issue.

The recent discussions between the western governments has left me to regret their disappointing attitudes but this has not come as a surprise. It is becoming increasingly clear that their so-called principles for human rights operate on different criteria than what should be expected. It is for this reason that I cannot see any principle decisions on their part which will assist you to eradicate apartheid and I fear that the only path open will be one of forceful overthrow.

In support of your efforts, I must mention that the most effective path would be to paralyse the security forces and my suggestion is to resort to biological warfare. This means that small amounts of debilitating bacteria could quite easily be fed into the food or water supplies which would cause long and debilitating recovery (not death).

I presume that your organisation has sufficient contacts to plant such bacteria in the places which matter, i.e. in the military basis or military cities. Alternately, to cause widespread contamination of the white suburbs.

I look forward to your comments and wish you good luck in your struggle.
