YOU may remember you very kindly helped us to obtain an article from Mr T Mbeke for a South Africa feature in World Statesman magazine's first issue. I am writing to request whether it would be possible to obtain an article by Mr N Mandela for our publication, the Commonwealth Ministers Reference Book, 1994 issue.

This publication is distributed to the Ministers and senior officials in central and state government in each of the member countries of the Commonwealth.

Previous contributors have included the President of the World Bank, the Prime Minister of Namibia, the Governor of Hong Kong, the UK Minister for Overseas Development, the Canadian and UK Defence Ministers, European Community Commissioners, and the Director General of the WHO, to name but a few.

The contribution should ideally be approximately 1,500 words long, and should be accompanied by a photograph and short biography. The final copy date for editorial is not until early 1994, but we would welcome Mr Mandela's decision as soon as possible so that we can inform the Commonwealth Secretariat.

I am writing this letter due to the urgency of the matter, but can send you a copy of last year's Commonwealth Ministers Reference Book for your reference
