Report to the Chief Representative Office ANC Maputo
From the Regional Youth Committee - 3 November 1987

Comrades, we hereby want to inform you, as it normally should be, about what the Regional Youth Committee (RYC) has been doing recently, its plans and problems.

The two former Chief Representatives in our region both correctly stressed the need for proper communication between the Office and the RYC, in writing and verbally, at all times.

The fact that this has not been the case for some time now, has largely been due to disorganization on our part and also to some extent due to Office's own problems.

Nevertheless, we now wish to see a different chapter opening between the Office and the RYC, as well as between the RYC and the newly-elected NYC at the 2nd National Youth Conference held in August 1987 in Tanzania.

Considering the unproductiveness of the youth's work since the beginning of 1987,

Noting the positive work done by the youth in ~~the~~ 1987,

And finally realizing the need for better organization and political life, the RYC, in line with a decision taken at the previous regional youth conference in September 1985, ~~the~~ has decided to call a similar conference for November the 8th, 1987.

The remaining members of the RYC, Cdes Tom, Dan and Fatima, recently held their first proper meeting for many months.

We therefore realized that a regional youth conference was essential to galvanize the youth's activities.

The present remaining RYC also strongly felt that our work should be geared mainly towards the constant upliftment of our youth's political awareness and towards the unswerving construction of ever strong ties with the Mozambican Youth Organization.

We hope that the Regional Youth Conference will be well attended and will come out with a new RYC to face up to the evergrowing challenges of our revolution in all fronts.

It is imperative to get organized.

The present RYC, as an outgoing committee, will make several recommendations to the conference on some local problems that have affected the youth's work in the past two years.

Of course, the Office will always be there to help us between now and the holding of the youth conference on Sunday morning the 8th of November.
