  - b. A memorandum was written to the same ministry a copy of which was sent to the Secretariat (Received 2/3/77 dated 16/2/77)
  - c. This was followed up with the ministry but so far there has not been any response. We feel (Canadian AN.C.) that the Canadian government will not issue the ministerial answerfor fear of creating a precedence whereby it will open the door for the P.L.D.) will continue to persue all possible attempts by soliciting support from fraternal organisations, Trade Unions, churches and non-governmental organisations if in the event that this fails our committeex strongly feels for a fultime office to be established.
