1) India

Plans have already been made to try to get a list of all students in this are. This will, atleast enable us to work out some swheme for making contact.

4)Ireland

A trip by one of us ,ie., known people to the area, without preparatory work does not yield much resylts. It is important that we must have somebody in the area who will constantly monitor the situation and we can act on the basis of these reports. I have made a contact but we must try to find others.

Kader is in a very good position and we must consider whether he cannot be asked to spend more time on this. The least we can do is initiate a long discusion with him on the whole situation in his area. He could be asked to give us some items contrat who we could than handle.

I am also trying to ensure that if a meeting is being organised in Ireland, either by the universities or by the AA., we should be informed so that we can use these as pretexts for being in the area.

to get some picture of the situation there.
