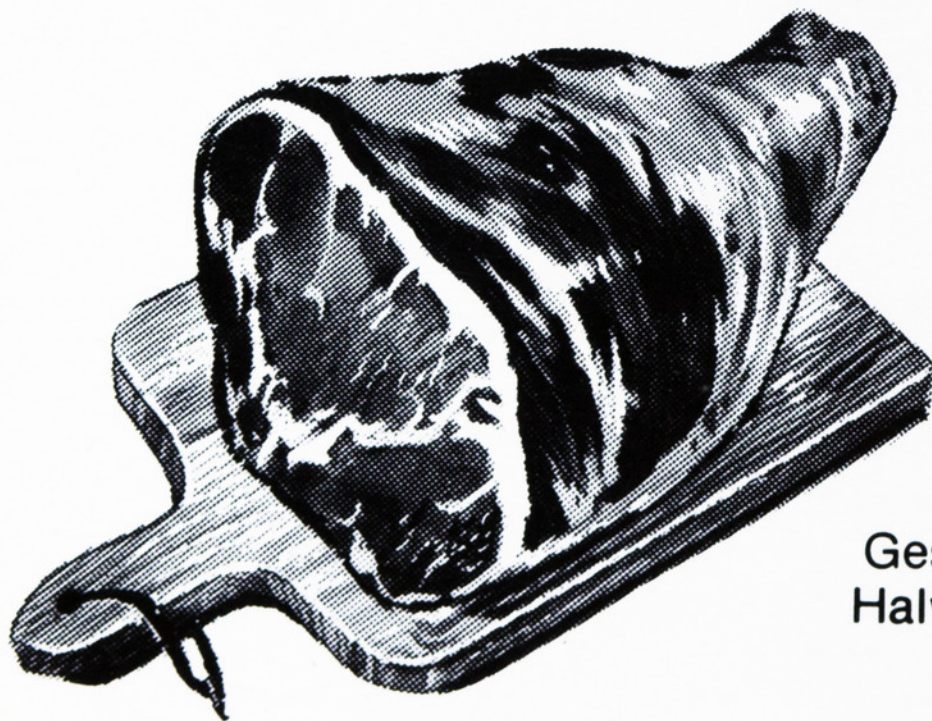

HASSAN HOWA President, South African Cricket Board of Control

On this historic Occasion when for the first time, a semi-massed tournament is being played at Mossel Bay I am sure most of you are conscious of the progress cricket has made in South Africa since it was decided to play cricket on a provincial basis.

Over the last few years our cricket has shown such startling progress that I am confident that within 5 years we will be playing international cricket not as black or white persons, but as South Africans.

To merit this right, however, everybody connected with cricket must make sure that our players are ready for this step. Administrators, players and spectators must decide that all obstacles facing us are regarded as a challenge to be overcome by our own efforts and that our dignity as South Africans shall never be sacrificed for the sake of expediency or lack of Moral courage.

moment, hold the reigns of authority, are taught to respect the dignity and ability of all South Africans.

This respect will never be accorded to people who are ready to go hat in hand to receive handouts, nor will it be given to those who have no pride and self-respect.

To those who think they are getting away with paying lip-service to the principles of our Board. I can only repeat my own philosophy of life. "If nobody else knows what I am doing - God and I will know and that is important for those two are my greatest judges."

May I wish you a happy and profitable (not necessarily financial) tournament. God bless all your efforts and Compliments of the Season to you all.

I take this opportunity of sending my good wishes to cricketers and Officials participating in the South Zone Cricket Tournament, at Mosselbay, during the festive season.

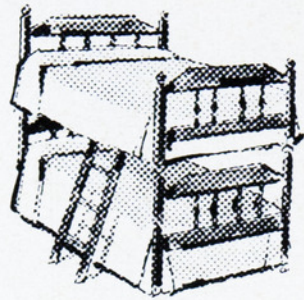
