We have been advised by Mr. Enuga Reddy of the United Nations Centre against Apartheid that you have been fortunate enough to be able to escape incarceration in South Africa. Also, that you will in all likelihood be invited to the United Nations in the last week of March, 1980.

We would be extremely interested in having you visit the province of Quebec and to participate in informational meetings with interested groups. The fact that you are able to speak French is of importance to us since 85% of the Quebec population are French-speaking. I also spoke to Jusuf Saloojee, the official A.N.C. representative in Toronto, Canada, and we agreed that your visit here could be extended into a cross-Canada tour.

Please let us know what your plans are as soon as possible, so that we can make the necessary plans to receive you.
