1. Applicant

Address

2. The Zonal Youth Committee is an ANC Youth organ with the same aims as those of the ANC. Locally, the Committee organises political, social and economic activities of the working youth and students at Mazimbu.

Political activities consist of general meetings, political discussions, news analysis, and any tasks assigned by the leadership.

Social activities consist of cultural activities, concerts, sports, etc.

Economic activities consist of organisation of working brigades to help in building and maintenance of the Mazimbu complex and to help in administration.

3. Project description:

A Youth Social Centre will have the following sections:

• meeting room.

• rooms for games such as chess, billiards, darts, etc.

• a tuck shop where refreshments can be bought.

• playgrounds for children.

• music/video facilities.

The Social Centre will be run by the ZYC (Zonal Youth Committee) and will serve as a place where the youth, residing in Mazimbu will have the opportunity to undertake leisure activities.

Members of the youth will play an important role in maintenance of the building, organisation of activities for children, running of the tuck shop. The eventual profit that will result from selling refreshments, will be used for keeping up the stock of the shop and for creating a social fund that will be used to organise activities for the youngest children residing in the day care centre and nursery school at Mazimbu.

4. The Social Centre is situated in Mazimbu, a community school and complex for South Africans in exile, administered by the ANC. Mazimbu is at a distance of approx. 5 kms North of MDPDQDFO.

5. The target group to benefit from the project are primarily the young members of the Mazimbu community. A social fund will be created that will be used for organising excursions, birthday parties for little children, Christmas parties, entertainment of young visitors, etcetera.

6. The Old building, destined for use by the Youth Committee for the Social Centre, was renovated by the youth themselves. Furniture was provided \$DP by the QNC Furniture workshop. Minor fittings to beautify the place were made by the Mazimbu maintenance department. There has been no financial input yet from the treasury due to lack of funds.

7. In DPEP to be able to start work with the implementation of the project, we presently are in need of the following :

- coffee machine (capacity approx. 20 cups)
- ice cream machine
- a freezer (capacity 500 lbs)
- cutlery, cups and glasses.

with initial stock for the tuck shop.

8. The project material will be owned by the ANC. All securities of AME members are directly under the Treasury Department, but administered by the respective branches, in this case the Zonal Youth Committee.

9. The amount requested CDH/Pib/Util/Dn out of the HAP fund is estimated as follows :

- coffee machine (capacity 20 cups) approx. 200 US \$
- ice cream machine approx. 600 US \$
- freezer (capacity 600 lbs) approx. 600 US \$
- " glasses, cutlery, cups. Teh. 50.000
- tuck Shop initial stock:

sweets, biscuits, etc. Teh. 10.000

soda 75.000

beer 250.000

coffee 5.000

sugar 2.500

mint 3.500

10. The requested aid concerns a new time contribution to the project.

11. No contributions have been requested from other organizations.

12. The project can start as soon as the required material arrives in Mazimbu, that is, as soon as the truck can start operating. The other equipment, which will probably take longer to acquire, will be installed when the project is already functioning.

13. The Zonal Youth Committee (Chairperson) and the Regional Project Director of the AND have been instructed to take charge of the implementation process.

14. The Chairperson of the ZYC and the Regional Project Officer of the QNC, will be responsible for the elaboration of financial and progress reports on the project.

15. Preferably, the amount of requested money should be made available in cash to the Chairperson of the ZYC or the Regional Project Officer. A cheque could be forwarded to the QNC office in Dar es Salaam.

It must be noted that the amount required for the truck shop initial stock could be paid in Tanzanian shillings, as these articles are to be acquired on the local market where they are readily available.

The required equipment will probably have to be ordered abroad which implies that the money should be forwarded in foreign currency.
