Thank you very for the nine boxes of clothing which arrived here in condition. Shipping of all materials on hand is expected to be sent off in the second week of January.

FOOD is still the top priority at present since there is a desperate shortage of even the most basic food in Angola at the camps/. We are making the necessary arrangements to air-freight an emergency supply within the next two weeks of canned meats, soup, powdered milk and powdered vegetables.
