Born in Pietermaritzburg, Natal. Left the country for political reasons. Worked with "Swasi Theatre Club" in Swaziland. Actress in the film "Soweto in Exile".

Born in Msinga, Natal. Worked with "Ipi Tombi" and left the production for political reasons. Worked also with "Freedom Singers" in New York, USA, and Dollar Brand (LP "Liberation"). Performances with Miriam Makeba and Hugh Masekela.
