

ADDRESSES

- 1 (a) The address of a telegram should be sufficiently full to enable it to be delivered without difficulty. A town address should contain the name of the street and if possible the number of the house. Include the name of the nearest Telegraph Office if the place has no telegraph service. (Delivery will be effected normally by Post from this Office.)
(b) Telegrams may be addressed to Telephone or Telex Numbers. The telephone exchange and number or the Telex Number must be written in front of the addressee's name and telegraph delivery office. Where the exchange and delivery office have the same name, the former may be omitted.

WRITING OF TELEGRAMS

2. Senders are warned that indistinct writing is a frequent cause of errors in telegrams. It is recommended that telegrams be typed whenever possible. Please use Block Letters.

DELIVERY

- 3 (a) Telegrams are delivered free only within the recognised area of townships or within a radius of four miles from the Telegraph Office of delivery.
(b) Telegrams for ships in harbours, where delivery by boat is necessary will be accepted only if boat hire is prepaid.
(c) Telegrams addressed to Box Numbers will be placed in the box to await collection.

4. Replies may be prepaid priority of transmission obtained and repetition at each stage of transmission arranged on payment of additional fees.
