150 held as W.  
police storm  
Vista campus

More than 50 students at  
Vista Universityts Soweto  
campus were arrested by  
police yesterday on their  
first day of the planned  
week-long class boycott to  
force the administration to  
meet certain demands.  
Heevtly-armed riot police in-  
vaded the campus shortly utter  
2pm u the students gathered  
next to the lecture hall: to plan  
further action.  
A senior university officiel.  
who identified himself to The  
Star a: a Mr Lubhe. the regis-  
trar, gave orders to the police  
to errat the students.  
He told The Star the universi-  
ty had been cloned yesterday  
and no students were allowed to  
he on campus.  
A: the contingent of police  
moved on to the cam us. the  
students scattered in a l direc-  
tions with baton-wielding po-  
licemen tn hot pursuit.  
Poznho Monchust (26), a sec-  
ond year law student at the uni-  
vexsity. we: bleeding from the  
nose and mouth after he was al-  
legedly baton-charged by the  
police.  
"I tried to jump the fence as  
the police chased us around the  
campus. but I tell to the  
ground." Mr Monchust said.  
He said after he was beaten  
by the police he was ordered to  
leave the campus. but decided  
to approach a police colonel to  
lay a charge of assault.  
"The EUIBMI I018 me Hi E618  
the nearest police station," he  
said.  
Mr Monchnsi laid a charge of  
assault at the Orlando Police  
Station.  
An elderly female student.  
who ntd Ihe we: suffering from  
asthma. pleaded with the police  
while It the heck of a congested  
police van to open the door to  
give her etr.  
Lost shoe. and broken specte-  
clee left 1 mm picture in the  
wake of the police ectton.  
Spokeemen tor Soweto police  
Lieuteuent Govindsamy Merte-  
muthoo aid the students were  
arreeted after the university  
management had laid a charge  
0! tree  
He said the management

from Pretoria had come to sort out matter: It the university and ordered the students to leave the campus, but they re-tuned.

The students had earlier erected sheets on the campus and toytetoayed around the university grounds.

Students on all the university's campuses countrywide decided to emhuh on mass action this week. which would include clue boycotts. the erection of a squatter cam on university ground: and e occupation of olncee and lecture hall: to force the administrauon to meet their demands.

OThe rearrangement of the examination timetable. which they allege h congested.

OProv'uiou of Students' rest-denca.

OProv'tsion ot tactllttes such as libraries and sports fields.

OA review of edm'uuons and exclusions polteles and the meaningful representation of we: not eveiuhle for comment.

Other Vista campuses such as Sehokeng and Mamelodt were reported to be normal.
