n2, 3T he meeting was irformed thatthe Lbrary Hojeet was encountering some  
hmmlal problems. A nm'berotpaymerm from Iastyer had to be paid from  
the curent years budget, and there was no such provision in the budget Also  
the expenses for the students were higher than eetinated. To meeteepeclally  
the costs forthe scholarsh progarrmeJhe Projectomoerstgeed to reeomnend  
tothe Finnldatmtrunds al I'ortheconetruotionotthe c B'Icklaying Shed  
be hardened to the Lbrary Project All the relevant etructues had been lrl'ormed  
about the mtter.

- The meeting was wormed that a Flnnlda detegatlion would showy vist Maztrbu  
and Dakawa. The merian reminded the comrnlttee that a Inary budget proposal  
for next year was approved by the eomnuue in May to be preserted to the Finnida.  
Howevec some changes - especially concemlng the scholarshb progarrme -  
have since taken place, and t was ageed that the budget could be updated  
accordingly.

- Cde M.S.E.P. Lmhull left on 30 Septmbortor his degee level studies in UK.  
The comnltee was also Idotmed that Cde nobertththenbu, studying In UK for  
his BA(Hom) Degee, had been given two warnings abet! misbehaviou' and  
mishandling money. . .

- Since since more students more due to the arrival studies on 21 October the libraries would again face problems with personnel. The committee felt, however, that the scholarship programme should be a priority even at the expense of the minor situation at Mazharu and Dakawa.
  - The committee was informed that Marjatta Lahti would finish working at Mazharu on 27 October. Kristiina Aspelund as the Head of Department in the library. Norkululeko Woko, who would in December resume the duties of the Head Librarian. Penitl When would act as the Coordinator of the May Project until his departure in February.
  - Recruitment for the replacement of Ode Penitl at Delawa is still going on in Finland, since the earlier candidate is no longer available for the job.
  - The repair work of the archive section had now been completed. The archive material had already been moved to the section. The librarian expressed concern about the lack of relevant material in the section. It was resolved that all items should be made to obtain archival material at least from Mazharu and Dakawa. Ode Sisa promised to help in the matter.
  - The video screens, with built loudspeakers, were received by the May. The librarian suggested that they be placed in Unit Two and Five halls after the furniture factory had combusted the trolleys and the cupboard for them. It was resolved that one of the screens be placed in Unit Five hall as soon as possible, the doors and windows of the Unit Two hall should be repaired before it would be safe enough for the screen.
  - The librarian told the meeting that a letter had been sent to Christopher Merrell, the Deputy University Librarian of Natal, welcoming a visit of a SA librarian to Somafo. The Director explained that he had informed Ode Makgothi to expect such an application in the near future.

- Ode Penitl told the meeting that M. Esa Paaso, a Finnish architect, visited Dakawa in August, and had now submitted the first plans for the proposed new library building at Dakawa. The Planning Department would have a meeting the following Wednesday, and the comments would then be sent to Finland soonest possible. The final plan is supposed to be ready by the end of the year.
