Professor Lena Dominelli



Lena Dominelli has an outstanding record in her battles on issues of human rights, citizenship, child sexual abuse from a feminist perspective, diversity, oppression, policy changes and improved services for women, in the pursuit of social justice. She is one of the most critical thinkers in the field of Social Science and Development. Dominelli has published widely: 20 books, over 40 chapters in books, 50 journal articles and several monographs. She is respected in the international arena for her contribution to curriculum development, in the areas of anti-oppressive practices and social development.

Dominelli drew on Ghandian principles of non-violent confrontations, to fight her human rights battles. As the President of the Simon Fraser Students' Union, Dominelli successfully led a student strike and discussions with the university authorities resulted in the reinstatement of the teachers involved.

In Algeria, she studied Arabic and French and subsequently received an award from the schools inspectorate for her excellent work on language acquisition amongst students.,

She is the founder member of the International Association of Schools of Social Work (IASSW). Dominelli is currently a researcher at the University of Durham in the UK.

The University of KwaZulu-Natal honours Lena Dominelli for her contribution to curriculum development, especially in the area of anti-oppressive practices and social development.
