Although talks have at present broken down, I am writing to you to draw attention to the under-representation of women delegates at the recent CODESA meetings. Now is surely the time to redress the balance before negotiations resume, as we trust they will.

CODESA's DeclaratiOn of Intent included the assurance that we are working towards a South Africa which 'will be a united, democratic, non-raeial and nnn-qexict state'. The composition of CODESA caused many to question the commitment to the ideal of non-sexism. Protests about the lack of participation of women at CODESA led to the formation of the Gender Advisory Committee which was welcomed. They also led to the realisatiou that the under-representation of women at CODESA derived ? largely from party political decisions.

.. Why is it that zour party had so few women participating at CODESA? The answer that women are not to be found high in party hierarchies is not a satisfactory response. Firstly, keeping women out of the constitution making process simply petpetuates this problem. Secondly, South African women have been actively involved in a broad range of political activities during the lag: decades. Names of capable South African women engaged in polltlcs (as opposed to party politics) are readily available. t

In due course there will be an interim government in South Africa, one in which we fear women will have a very Small voice. Women constitute just over half this country's population. We are not an 'interest group' or a minority group; we are also voters for the future South African government.

As a women and as a voter I would like to know what your party \$ntends to do to ensure that women are fully represented in an . Luterim government and beyond?

This is why we are asking you, as one of the leaders, to come to the Dedication Dinner and to participate.

Our objective is, as we shall be saying again in the invitation, to encourage Christians in leadership positions to recognise their privileges, responsibilities and accountability before God, to reaffirm their faith and to renew the dedication of our country and themselves to God and His purposes - to the glory of our Lord.

We have never asked specifically for a financial contribution towards the cost of the dinner, which has previously been borne mainly by the hosts and other committed friends. However, so many guests have asked in the past whether they could make a contribution that this year we are providing for it on the reply card of the invitation.

We shall be sending you a final invitation to this important Christian occasion later, but meanwhile please diarise the date.

. My dear Prayer Partners in South Africa,

Greetings in the precious name of JeSus!

The Old Testament world is "God loved Israel" (2 Chronicles 9:8, KJV). The Gospel is "God so loved the world " (John 3: 16). The one Christian word whosoever has been mankind's single greatest force of emancipation, before which intolerance and exclusiveness melt away. "There go the ships" (Psalm 104:26, KJV), said the Psalmist, to scour the seven seas, transporting the golden news of salvation. "I am debtor both to the Greeks. and to the Barbarians; both to the wise. and to the unwise" (Romans 1:14. KJV), said that one-time fanatical bigot Saul of Tarsus when at last the love of Christ constrained him. Glory to God.

Today I have some fantastic news for you:

THE OPENING OF THE RON GATES OF ISLAM

Our most significant Gospel crusade in five years

Conakry, Guinea

27 October - 1 November 1992

. It was like a dream! We were in the centre of a Muslim (95 per cent) nation and saw the awesome power of a Holy Ghost revival!

"You shall slam through the iron gates of Islam," I had heard the Holy Spirit tell me ten years ago. This Gospel crusade was a grand slam of the living God.

Never before had there been a crusade in this city. Conakry had only 3,000 bom-again Christians. All evangelical church denominations, 15 different pastors, co-operated.

The difficulties in getting this crusade off the ground were immense. We had one cancellation after another. Once it was cancelled because the Pope was to come, another time because of a football game in the stadium. But we are people with staying-power - and God made a way!

President Conte is a Muslim, married to a Catholic who was bom-again in February of this year. Beset by diverse problems, and realising that her church's prayers didn't help, she sent a candle and some money to one of the charismatic churches, asking for prayer assistance. The pastor sent both the candle and the money back, stating that he needed neither for effective prayer. The First Lady met this man of God and was gloriously saved. Last week she attended every single service in the stadium in Conakry, sitting on the platform, rejoicing in the Lord, with about 100 soldiers swarming around her for security.

MIGHTY MIRACLES

For the first meeting 42,000 people arrived. Among them. we were told, were some Muslims armed with stones to throw at me when no miracles happened. What did

happen was that a blind man in their midst received his sight - and multitudes of others were healed! The power of the Gospel exploded all over the stadium, and the wonderful news spread in all directions.

The following day 50,000 people were there. Again we saw multitudes receiving J esus Christ as their personal Saviour.

The third day brought trouble. There was shooting in the city because of an attempted coup. All public transport stopped. Our crowd in the evening dwindled to 25,000. but grew again rapidly. In six meetings I preached to a total of 240,000 Guineans. What a joy and privilege!

A Muslim family brought their three children, who were all born blind. George, a boy of 13. was the oldest; he had learned to read and write braille. During the prayer for healing. his eyes popped open - completely and perfectly! His sister also saw, even if not yet perfectly! This rocked the Muslim community. George was summoned by high-ranking, Muslim government officials who wanted to see the miracle with their own eyes. Every member of the family was converted to Jesus Christ. .

When I left Conakry, little George came to say goodbye. "When I grow up, I want to preach the Gospel you preach," he told me with tears in his eyes. Praise the Lord, I believe that the next generation of evangelists will know a still mightier anointing than we know today. May he be one of them!

CHURCHES FLOODED WITH NEW CONVERTS

The participating churches were flooded with new converts when they held their Sunday morning services. During the six meetings of our Gospel crusade, our counsellors had given out 100,000 follow-up booklets to those Who made decisions for Christ. These dear people can now be followed up effectively! What a big bite for these churches to digest!

This Conakry Gospel campaign was one of the most signiificant we have had in the last five years because we saw what God could do in an almost completely Muslim nation! It has made me hungry to move to the northern regions of the African continent. Please continue to pray that this will happen very soon. .

PLEASE PRAY FOR ARGENTINA AND CAMEROON

By the time you receive this letter we would have had our first Gospel crusade in South America: Buenos Aires, Argentina. It promises to be a powerful breakthrough; over 500 churches are co-operating, and we expect a mighty harvest for Jesus. In December we have our last crusade of the year in Africa, in the city of Douala, Cameroon. Previous plans to go there had to be cancelled because of the warlike situation in that country, but now the crusade is on - in the name of Jesus!

Please help us to pray for the financing of the Argentine crusade. The expenses are horrendous (US\$ 250,000), and we are looking to Jesus alone! We know that we are moving in the centre of His will and therefore have perfect peace. Thank you for standing with us in this battle for millions of souls.
