The following agreement relates to the use of remaining tunda collected by the Scandinavian School Student Organisations (hereinafter referred to as "3850") during Nordic Operation Dayswork 1985 (NOD 85). The agreement is drawn up between The Batlegae Trust (Johannesburg, South Africa) and Danchurchaid (Copenhagen, Denmark). Danchurchaid (hereinafter referred to as "DCA") carries the administrative responsibility for the management of the NOD 85 funds as defined in the simultaneously drawn up agreement between DCA and SSSO.'
