I. Assessing the individual learning activities that are relevant to their felt national/A.N.C./ Educational needs:

The International Literacy Day: September 8th.

I. It was agreed that September 8th, 1982 should be the inauguration of Literacy Campaign at Solomon Mahlangu Freedom College. J8

II. The A. N. C. (S.A will address the learners etc. about the importance of education and how adult literacy can help liberate South Africa, its fight against ignorance, poverty and disease .
