Re: Deployment at National Logistics Department.

I am writing in response to your verbal request to be deployed at the above mentioned department as a truck driver.

I had earlier asked you to bring a letter from the head of your previous department (Communications) confirming that you were no longer deployed in the same department. The department was also to state reasons why you were no longer with it, if ever you have been relieved of your duties in the department.

I regret to inform you that the National Department of Logistics has turned down your request. The reasons being that the letter from the Communications Department, signed by the deputy head of the department, and delivered by you personally does not state any tangible reasons why you are no longer with the department, save to say you were on temporary deployment, and a new driver has been found or preferred by the department. This of course contradicts your verbal statement to me to the effect that you left the department on your own after you had an accident with the van belonging to that department.
