Assessment of the Republic of Nauru

Report by the Director-General

Following the admission of the Republic of Nauru to membership of WHO, and until the establishment of a United Nations rate of assessment for the Republic of Nauru by the United Nations General Assembly, the Director-General recommends that the Health Assembly fix a provisional assessment rate for this Member.

- 1. In accordance with Article 6 of the Constitution, the Republic of Nauru was admitted to membership
- of the World Health Organization by the Forty-seventh World Health Assembly on 5 May 1994 , subject to
- its depositing a formal instrument of acceptance of the WHO Constitution with the Secreta  $\rm ry\text{-}General$  of

the United Nations.

- 2. Pending a decision concerning the rate of assessment for this State by the United Nati ons General
- Assembly, on the basis of which the definitive assessment of the Republic of Nauru can be fixed by the
- World Health Assembly, the Director-General recommends that the Republic of Nauru be assessed at a
- provisional rate of 0.01% for the financial period 1994-1995 and for future financial periods, to be adjusted
- to the definitive assessment rate when established by the Health Assembly.
- 3. When considering the provisional assessment rate for the financial period 1994-1995, the Assembly
- will wish to take into consideration resolution WHA22.6 in which the Twenty-second World Health
- Assembly decided "that from 1968 new Members shall be assessed in accordance with the practice followed
- by the United Nations in assessing new Members for their year of admission".
- 4. In accordance with this practice, the 1994 instalment of the 1994-1995 assessment of the Republic of
- Nauru should be reduced to seven-twelfths of 0.01%.
- 5. In the light of the above considerations, the Health Assembly may wish to consider the adoption of
- ' a resolution along the following lines:
- The Forty-seventh World Health Assembly,
- Noting the admission of the Republic of Nauru to membership in the Organization;

Recalling that the Twenty-second World Health Assembly, in resolution WHA22.6, decided the

from 1968 new Members shall be assessed in accordance with the practice followed by the U nited

Nations in assessing new Members for their year of admission, DECIDES:

(1) that the Republic of Nauru shall be assessed for the financial period 1994-1995 and for

future financial periods at a rate to be fixed by the Health Assembly, as and when an assessment rate for this country has been established by the United Nations General Assembly;

(2) that the Republic of Nauru shall be assessed at the provisional rate of 0.01% for the financial period 1994-1995 and for future financial periods, to be adjusted to the definitive

assessment rate when established by the Health Assembly;

(3) that the 1994 instalment of the assessment shall be reduced to seven-twelfths of 0.01 %.
