Saraccas Farm Project (Nacarua)

Land Cultivation. We have a cleared land fit for cultivation which is about 350 hectares (2Km length and 700m breadth) We intend ploughing maize, pumpkins and watermelons.

a) Maize can be used for pig feed and for our own consumption this will greatly reduce the money which ought to be used for pig feed, as the pigs are starting to multiply.

b) Pumpkins this will be solely for market sale, as you know there is starvation around this province added by the fact that pumpkins have no lot of work to be done as they are irrigated by rains and they may be stored for some time and they are not easy perishable products similarly to watermelons.

. We have also

an area of 8 hectares which does not need much preparations to plough potatoes also for market sale. Therefore we need urgent assistance from our Regional treasurer:

a) To till the area with a tractor (before it starts to rain)

b) We also need the above mentioned seeds, the amount is as follows: - 1 bag of pumpkin seeds

- 5 bags of mielie seeds

- 1 bag of watermelon seeds

- 20 bags of potato seeds

As the farm is large and the area to be cultivated is extensive we need people to work, we need at least 8 general workers who will be paid monthly in hard cash, and of course others who must be paid with the second hand clothing, those are for weeding (scuffling off the grass) during rainy season and also for reaping, collecting products when they are already ripe. 10 bales of old clothing can be sent for the start.

EQEEgEEEEQE- The farm has dozens of cashew trees which this year they have borne a lot of cashew nuts, we also need old clothing to let people to collect them immediately as they are running out of season we may produce when collected 10- 15 bags of cashew nuts and the treasurer may advise us what to do with them or to send them to Maputo.

ggiggsyz We have 31 pigs at present 10 bores and 21 saws the rest
of the saws are expected to deliver although one has already
delivered 11 piglets within few days five are also expected to
deliver, and we intending to employ 4 permanent workers for piggery
as this stage we do not have the cement we are now using local
material for constructing pig stys
WEEEI' We have inserted old piping system for water it serves only a
little, because the pipes are old and they won't resist for 6 months
Therefore we request a 2 and a half inches pipe the length is 3-4KM
----- ' We are out of nails, screws, paint nets, curtains, whitewash
planks. We thought it necessary to renovate the present structures
as the rain is nearer a lot of our articles may get spoiled
because of the water leaking from the roof, we therefore need to
have four carpenters in order to speed up the renovation part we
also need two builders because of the renovation of this buildings
This are the following people I intend to employ of course if
approved by the Regional Treasurer.
