Minutes of meeting held on 12th September between ANC project officer
gTitus Kotsoez and HIVOS project officer (Irene Dubelz
The discussion concerned the support to be given by HIVOS for the
agricultural activities undertaken at both Mhzimbu and Dakawa farms.
Aesessing the present project relation (3780/3145) for agricultural inputs
it was concluded that bbth the logistics and the time-schedule have been
the major reasons for the unsuccessful implementation of the project sofar.
Sofar none of the ordered goods have reached Mazimbu, and despite a number .
of attempts undertaken both by EPICS (Netherlands) and ANC (Mazimbu and
Lusaka) the gobds have not been traced.

. . It was agreed that those implements which directly relate to the agriculturalx
cycle should be planned and ordered accordingly. Therefore the project period
fur the implements should be scheduled from 1st of July untill 30th of June
the next year.

The ARC expressed the wish to work_towards a more longeterm project relation-
ship with HIVOS in order to plan its agricultural programme in advance.
HIVOS project officer Will take this issue up at the HIVOS office.
HIVOS pointed out to the AFC that the communication should be improved.

ANC Mazimbu should keep HIVO? up-to-dete concerning the progress at
Mazimbu and Dakawa farms, as well as the expenditures of the project
according to the general project conditions of HIVOSo
It was agreed that from now on ANS Hezimbu itself will order the'required
goods, either through thitd parties or onits own, and will require HIVOS
. to transfer the money to respective bankacoounts.

Contracts should always be send to and signed by ANC project departmentyLusaka
at the same time cepies always have to be send to ARC project department?
Mazimbu.

The following projects are proposed by the ANC to HIVOS:

1. Agicultural inputs for Mazimbu and Dakawa, period lwln1288 to 30-6-1288

On a yearly basis the farms in Mazimbu and Dakawa require inyuts in the
fields of: e insecticides, _ herbicides, _ seeas, - veterinary medicines.
For details see enclosed lists.

Within the budget money should be allocated for activities in the field
of agricultural training. This training component should facilitate ANC members
who are wotking on the farms to acquaint themselves with modern farming
technology, preferably in the Netherlands, and in cooperation with the
ANC support committee ath the Agricultural University in Hageningen.

The study tour should include an exposure to dairy'farming, poultry, piggery, crop farming, agricultural training centres and the agro-y industry.

ANC will put forward a request for such a tour and aks HIVOS for assistance in organising.

2. Transport for the Dakawa farm

Almost urgent need in the Dakawa farm at Qresent is the lack of transPort facilities 6n the spot_for implements, people etc.

Therefore a diesel landuoruiser pick-up is requested.

3. Storage facilities for the Dakawa farm

At present storage facilities are almost hon-existent for both the inputs as well as the harvest in Dakawa.

A first priority should be given to the building of three separate storage buildings for the inputs: seeds, chemicals, fertilizers.

In terms of storage facilities for the harvest silo's should be build, similar to the ones at the farm in lhzimbu. The building of silo's could be spread out over alonger period.

A rough indication of the fauired budget will be provided. But a more detailed proposal will be send to HIVOS in the forthcoming months.

4. Poultgx division

A poultry division Will be set up in stages at Dakawa in order to provide eggs and meat for both Dakawa and Nazimbu communitiesg and in the long run possibly for the urban centres in Tanzania. Possibilities for the latter- are investigated at present.

At this stage a proposal has been put forward to CRIAA, in France. ANC has not yet received any answer, but might come to HIVOS to ask for assistance. The development of the poultry division rquires a substantial amount of funding, therefore different donors might be approached in the future.
