RECOMMENDATIONS

WOMEN AND EDUCATION IN S.A

1. A career guidance committee should be formed wherein women will be considered and guided for courses they should take for their development. There must be trained personnel on career guidance when will be part of the [Scholarship Committee.
2. Women should be represented in the National Scholarship Committee by an active person as the present representative is unable to do her duties due to ill-health. The women's representative should be elected at the National Conference.
3. There must be flexibility when comes to the 2-year period of serving, and comrades who are qualified in fields which are not available in Mazimbu must be deployed in friendly countries to gain experience, where possible, After which they should return to the movement
4. *Political maturity should be the guiding line but* All qualified personnel should come back and report to Mazimbu. *when there is personnel crisis, incentives should be* The question of the teacher's incentive should be reviewed. *considered.*
5. Adult education should be strengthened among women to develop them, and women in the Kate Molale Centre should be given special attention. Central Administation should immediately remove the comrades who do not qualify to be at Kate Molale Centre,
6. *The Primary school PTA should be revived* Re-establishment of Parents Teachers Association (PTA) and the staff problem should be looked into.
7. Women inside the country should be encouraged to join adult education.

8. Women at home should be at the forefront to demand for an alternative education for their children. More and more campaigns should be organised for better education.
9. Women should demand the immediate release of children who are held under the State of Emergency and call for the withdrawal of the police in the schools.

RECOMMENDATIONSWOMEN IN CULTURE

1. Cultural organisations at home should be encouraged to spread the ANC policy and bring more women to participate in the struggle.
2. Cultural groups at home should be encouraged to depict the conditions of women under Apartheid.
3. Women should be encouraged to participate in cultural activities. They should also be given scholarships to study the expressive arts and be encouraged to broaden their knowledge of other cultures.
4. ~~Our representative~~ ^{Women bartering} in the NEC should closely protect the women's interests. *Women bartering should be stopped by all means*
5. *Cultural front* should be strengthened which will work with women.
6. ^{women of local govt organisation} Constant contact with UWT should be maintained and meetings, debates, seminars and conferences and political gatherings should be held to develop our women.
7. Cultural activities be strengthened for the sake of exchanging cultural experiences.

CONTINUATION

8. Organisations like FEDSAW, UDF's Women Alliance should be encouraged to form cultural organisations and bring more women to participate in the struggle.
9. It was stated not to confine our culture to the performing arts only but to broaden it to areas such as the upbringing of our children to give them as broad an experience as possible while ensuring that they also acquire the distinctive South African Culture.
