As we mentioned in our letter of late August, there was some confusion over what a cheque forwarded to the ANC in May was intended to cover.

The cheque was for \$258 (a photocopy of the receipt is enclosed). It was to cover:

4 baseball hats at \$6 each - \$24.00
5 medals at \$2 each - \$10.00
25 postcard sets at \$3 each - \$75.00
3 records at \$8 each - \$24.00
2 Namibia books at \$1.50 each - \$3.00
Total - \$136.00

The cheque was also to cover a year's subscription to Sechaba and Newsbriefs; the rest is a (unfortunately small) donation. (We recently received a Newsbriefs subscription renewal notice, and we believe that the May cheque already paid the renewal cost.)

We are about to embark on a new fundraising effort for SOMAFCO, and would be interested in again selling ANC "paraphenalia". Could you please forward a list of what items you will have available for the 75th Anniversary. The things that we sold last year did very well. We would also appreciate pamphlets, buttons, etc.

We are also interested in conducting a material aid campaign for the ANC's southern African community. Could you please also forward a list of the specific items needed by the community that would be easy to collect at a university.

We apoligize for any inconvenience that getting back to you so late causes you on this matter, but the McGill Board of Governors just held its first review of last year's divestment decision, and we've all been bogged down with that (they reaffirmed the decision, in case you hadn't heard yet).
