MINUTES OF A MEETING HELD BETWEEN THE MISSION'S ADMINISTRATION AND THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ANC STUDENT COMMUNITY ON THE 4TH JANUARY 1993 AT THE CHIEF REPRESENTATIVE'S OFFICE.

Agenda: Request for transport until after writing exams.

The chairman explained that the three comrades approached him and were asking the mission to reverse the decision taken to withdraw transport for students. He revealed that this request is said to be necessitated by the fact that the students are presently writing exams.

The students were told that their problem is understandable and they will be assisted if possible. It was also noted that the whole issue depends on what the TGO Committee is to say since they are the ones in conjunction with HQ who made the decision.

It was further suggested that this is a very difficult question because HQ had to reverse its deadline on several occasion in the past. That this issue should not involve the administration but should be handled by the education desk which in turn must work with the TGO Committee.

It was then resolved that Comrade Gavin should deal with the issue in conjunction with Comrade Awolo Mogau. That the two comrades will have to discuss and explore the possibility of issuing petrol stamps for the two weeks being requested by the students for writing exams.

The students also asked as to why did the office not look for funds from sponsor in order to maintain transport for the.

It was explained that as far as the ANC is concerned it is selling all its cars except those to remain for the mission, that even the mission will remain with very few cars.



Comrade Bob told the meeting that as far as he is concerned there are people who will finish their courses in December 1993, including himself. Therefore he thought that the office will have to provide them with transport. The group which is to remain is very small and therefore cannot be a very big burden to the office.

It was then explained to him that among those presently 'studying' there are some who are not serious. That the ANC HQ had explained to everyone that there is no money and that people who intend to remain and study should look for sponsors who will provide them with all the necessities failing of which a person should go home.

That therefore there is no point as to why Bob is raising this issue as decisions have already been taken and they are final.

The meeting ended with agreement that the students will be told of the outcome of a meeting between Comrade Gavin and Comrade Awolo.

**NOTE:**

Earlier on the students mentioned that they are opposed to the practise of the office of collecting Comrade Kwasa-Kwasa (Aaron Mayenzeke) because he is using their car. They went on to say that their complaints are stemming from the fact that when they confronted Ntate Awolo he told them that the stamp which he gave Chileshe was meant for students and was the last one.

This then gave the students a loophole because the other members of the administration had told them that the assistance that has been given to them will no longer continue from that day (04/01/93) as it was resolved in earlier meetings that 31st of December is the deadline.
