### WHAT HAS C.A.R.A. BEEN UP TO LATELY?

Oct 16-Nov 16	C.A.R.A. was involved, along with the Edmonton Learner Centre and the Alberta Federation of Labour, in a tour featuring Peter Mahlangu, Chief ANC Rep in Canada and Bafo Nyanga, SACTU Rep to Canada. The tour included visits to seven schools (4,000 students), the AFL Fall School in Jasper and meetings with various Alberta Labour Councils and trade unionists.

Mar 7-11	Visit by Chief ANC Rep to Canada, Peter Mahlangu included an assembly at Ross Sheppard Composite High School for 1200 students, a forum at the U of A co-sponsored by the Graduate Students' Association, his introduction to the Legislative Assembly, a talk at the Edmonton and District Labour Council, and a social.
