

Dear Chairperson,


As you may be aware, Church Leaders convened an Emergency Meeting on Friday, August 6th, 1993 to discuss the alarming upsurge of violence in the East Rand and throughout the country following the announcement of the election date.

We are thoroughly convinced that urgent intervention is required to curb this violence which has claimed over 700 lives since June 3rd this year.

For this reason we would to ask for a hearing with the Multiparty Negotiations Council to represent matters raised by Church Leaders in that meeting.
