EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFESSIONS OF AN ENEMY AGENT RALPH MGCINA ALIAS FEAR WHO DIED OF NATURAL CAUSES RECENTLY.

According to the confession of Ralph Mgcina made towards the end of May 1988, ha attended the University of the Western Cape (UWC) in 1973. After its closure due to student protests he ended up in Durban living with his sister, while searching for a job. He could not get the job. It is at this time that he was recruited by a white man to work for the South African Special Branch. He made contact with the SASO office in Durban and also medical students who were politically active and submitted reports to his handler on their activities.

Early in 1974 he was instructed to go back to the Western Cape and enrol at UWC in order to monitor the. political situation there. At this time many students were leaving the country because of police harrassment and joining the NLM in exile. He was instructed to join these students - leave the country, join thf ANC in particular, study its internal situation, gair experience and remain dormant in it.

Ho remade contact with the enemy when he was deploye in Swaziland being serviced by couriers to and fro hi brother in law-Paul Mover who is a policeman i Lusikisiki. Paul Meyer was the linkman with the mai handler who is a senior security branch officer. Hi main task was to keep close to MHQ personnel, analyr MHQ strategic thinking, and with time establish t main lines of ANC work in developing the anr* struggle.

In 1983 whilst deployed as a leading cadre in one of our military machineries in Swaziland he was arrested by the Swazi policemen. He knew that one of these policemen, Andrew_Ndlovu is working for the South African SBs. During questioning he revealed to Andrew Ndlovu the following information about his unit in Swaziland: that comrade Zweli (Ghebuza's brother)is

commander of the unit? that comrade Magagula is in charge of logistics in the area? that Madolo works for Border infiltration; also the infiltration point, codes of communication and the DLBs. Ile never told the comrades about what he told Andrew Ndlovu.

The agent then was introduced by the police statior: RICHARD DLAMINI commander^ to two Boers who introduced themselves as; captain Van Nikerk and Van Der Walt who wanted to know about the places where ANC people stay. One of these places they were interested to know about was where comrade Zweli stayed and this happened to be the same place of the agent. He described and drew a sketch of the house which was at Moneni. They told him that they wanted to attack the place but needed his collaboration to effect this plan. He agreed to do this.

In his words, "my task would be to alert them as to whet the comrades were asleep and to unlock the back door, switch off the outside light for the attack, keep in touch with Richard Dlamini and break my bedroom window to 'effect my survival". He did exactly as instructed by his masters and the result was that comrades Zweli and Keith Macfadden wore killed in that raid through his practical assistance to the Boers.

Also on the basis of his experience in MK work, ho was also instructed to push MHQ for deployment in the country which he did. The enemy was confident that he would succode in doing this due to his experience at tho front. The enemy objective was that he would

develop his own structure and also rise in HK structures inside the country. The strategic goal of the enemy here was to allow tho structures inside the country to grow and then cut them down, but leave an ftrahryn fnr th« ANC to bui.ld on and within that embryo leave its own forces so that the new structure is also controlled. This would go on indefinitely. He died before implementing this next enemy plan.
