Requisition submitted to the Minister for Development Co-operation, Netherlands Government by the African National Congress of South Africa in support of assistance for the Year 1982.

Background:

The position in South Africa has recently entered a new phase. Pretoria's unwarranted and aggressive invasion of Angola introduces a new dimension of militaristic expansion that threatens the stability of all countries throughout Southern Africa. Spokesmen for neighbouring states like Zambia, Mozambique and of course Angola itself have emphasised the dangers to peace resulting from Pretoria's calculated adventurism. The evidence shows that the invasion has been carried out with the tacit approval of the Reagan administration. Without it's backing Pretoria would hardly have dared to defy African opinion and that of the majority of United Nations community.

One of the most important tasks facing our Movement is to mobilise South Africans of all colour groups and classes for Peace, against militarisation and in support of the movement taking shape in many countries to halt the arms race. Our country is very much part of the growing menace of nuclear war. Not only because South Africa has all the resources required for the manufacture of nuclear weapons (if it has not done so already) and more particularly because the regime has menacingly offered to place it's ports, airfields and other facilities at the disposal of Nato.

During the course of this year, the expenditure on armaments was increased by 40% at the expense of social and welfare services, education, housing and benefits for unemployed. This contrast between the extraordinary spending on armaments and the miserly economies on social welfare is apparent to many sections of the population. The indications are that this could be made the central issue in a campaign for peace within the country. This campaign should arise from the people themselves through the mass institutions and organisations including

the popular press, student bodies, churches, trade-unions, progressive parties and welfare organisations.

Such activities must however be stimulated and organised by the Liberation Movement itself before they can become really effective.

Our struggle against Apartheid will continue as before on all fronts - politically, economically, culturally and militarily. There is no contradiction between a peace movement and our armed struggle. The biggest contribution which the National Liberation can make towards Peace is to dismantle Apartheid by overthrowing the racist regime. This regime harnesses the entire resources of the country to maintain the hegemony of Afrikanerdom by perpetuating white minority rule and rejecting all attempts to reach a peaceful solution by extending democratic rights to all sections of the population.

Conclusion:

Ours is a hard and long struggle. It's success however is being demonstrated recently where on the one hand there are divisions within the ranks of the ruling National Party on such basic issues such as the trade union rights for black workers and on the other hand by it's armed aggression against it's neighbouring states. Both are indicative of growing crises within the ruling party and the white minority as a whole.

Appeal:

With these considerations in mind, we appeal for support from all our allies and friends for material aid which we can claim with justification has been used economically and for the purpose intended. This help has enabled us to achieve many positive results in the past and will be even more important in the future.

Description of Aid:

The humanitarian aid required covers a wide canvas which includes food, shelter, medicine, kitchenware, electronics, clothing, transport, stationery and various other aspects of refugee life. There are also of course various projects such as farms, school and printing amongst others which need attention. Scholarships and tickets for transport of refugees to safe areas are also some of our responsibilities.

Geographical Coverage:

The aid required is spread over a wide area covering all the front-line countries. The main ports of call are Luanda, Dar-Es-Salaam and Maputo. There is a constant and increasing demand coming from within our country itself, a fact which we regard as very significant and which is regarded as a top priority.

Problems:

Shortages of many items in all the front-line states, fluctuating prices and unprecedented inflation combined with shortage of cash makes the welfare of all the refugees a n extremely difficult situation to cope with. It also makes it almost impossible to quantify goods satisfactorily or with any precision.

Addresses:

The three main addresses are appended. In some cases goods are listed for a specific area in others you are requested to divide up a list into two or three ways for different zones.

Goods directed to Luanda are distributed throughout Angola: Those to Dar will go to Tanzania, Zambia and possibly Botswana. Similarly from Maputo, Mozambique will be replenished as well as Swaziland. Hence the necessity for long distance transport in the shape of trucks, landcruisers and vans.

Wherever possible, all goods should be sent in wooden crates as cartons tend to be broken on long trips and to avoid pilfering.
