D. Drags

This is a monthly exercise and is called Air-Re³supply. The sizes of drags vary between 3 ~ A aircraft with #5 ~ 60 parachute. This is done by the SADF Air-Force without any cover. This is done with the MNR preparing such places for a drone inside Mozambique. Each such drop was done with two fires on one side and five on the other and the drops are made to land in the middle of the fire circle through parachutes. These drops are run by the 28 Squadron from Matarklanf air^{200\224}base.

The camp could have been moved after it was discovered that it was knemn, but the problem is that it has a lot of facilities which have been laid there for training purposes, and that makes it difficult to transfer. It has the function of training about 200 people at a time, which 6 - 9 months. The recruits all come from Mozambique and when they finish they are all taken back and another batch recruited.

h. DPERRTIDN BRPG

This is a sub-operation of Operation Mile. It is a special sabotage squad and is run by Lt. Hurter (code name) Gunther who is responsible to Col. van Niekerk.

Hurter lived in Namibia for a long time until recently, he is always armed with a Soviet pistol (Tekerev) and a knife. He had problems with his clearance from the security police as he is trigger happy.

This Operation consists of 9 people who have had very extensive training, they all look like coloured and earn R208 monthly. They start at times at their base somewhere around Hometipoort and they try to observe very tight security.

* A week before Crietine's death the 9 members made their way into Mozambique, at same point near Hometipoort and there made contact with a border patrol which they tried to bribe, and, failing to

do so, they killed the members of the patrol.

They were infiltrated in groups of two and three and only five of them managed to come back. The other four have not been seen again. Subsequently two more were recruited and their number now stands at seven (7)

This arrangement was the set-up before the death of the secretary Cristina, and was changed after his death to Entambeni. Ululu has since moved to Kenya and the President Alfonso to St. Michael. Lt. Samba is said to be inside Mozambique since February, while his brother is suspected dead after a court martial after a secretary's death. It is said that since that moved from Pretoria that he no longer produces tapes for the radio.

0 Daily handling of the tape

This was how they used to handle the tapes while they were still in Pte. The tape was taken from Ufal to Payton Building and handed to the Directorate of Communication operations. The tapes were to be delivered at 1.30 p.m. and 3.38 p.m. they were taken to the post office (which served as a sort of communication centre). This place was near Halfway House called Dlifantefentein; it is obvious from the numerous antennas there.

The death of General Secretary Orlando Cristina

He was shot on a Sunday night and the following day some national servicemen were put on duty to guard the house at Ufal. These servicemen

were armed with 0021 light machine guns and three

533. Later on Monday evening the security police came and took all 15 MNR personnel staying at the Farm and interrogated them one by one.

After all had been interrogated, on Tuesday the prime suspects were taken for interrogation. These included Francisco Bombs, Macheva and two MNR Presidents guards of whose rifles were used in the shooting. Re Free Wednesday the prime suspects were taken away by the Security Force for thorough interrogation.

At this point stories started going around that this was a purely internal MNR problem.

About a week later Machsva's one of the Presidents guards were cleared by the Security Police. Bombs and a Zimbabwean called Macacala were never seen again after being taken in for interrogation. It is said that Samba ordered the President's

guard to pull the trigger that killed the secretary Cristina, while the President himself was still in Mozambique from where he returned about 10 days later. After Machsva was cleared by the security police, he disappeared (sscspsd) as he felt that his rule was not clearly understood and has since never appeared

on the scene again. He (Nachsva) escaped after he was supposed to be waiting for a driver to take them back to camp, in a car that was parked at the front of Zanzu Building.

On June 2, a Dakota Na. ZSLJ 1, a grey aircraft with a blue stripe was used by 15 MNR commanders including the President and Raul Diqua,

and they were all in full uniforms, had a helicopter and ammunition. They left St. Mislie early in the morning and went back on the night in a military aircraft at waterkloof sir Essa. Speculation is that this mission was a court martial of the two people the Zimbabwean and Bombs who were then executed.

3. zssu srsnr (CITY)

This is a training base of the Mhla-201. It is about 30km north of Phalahrwa, on the Kruger Park border. It is widely believed that this very camp is known by the Mazsembicsh authorities.

Just as you approach the Kruger Park gate there is an insignificant gate to your left with a sign post reading Imnals base. You proceed from here along the Kruger Park border and this distance is about

30km, and then you will pass the second guard, as you go on you will then turn left and as you go zig-zagging there you will be confronted with the camp itself.
