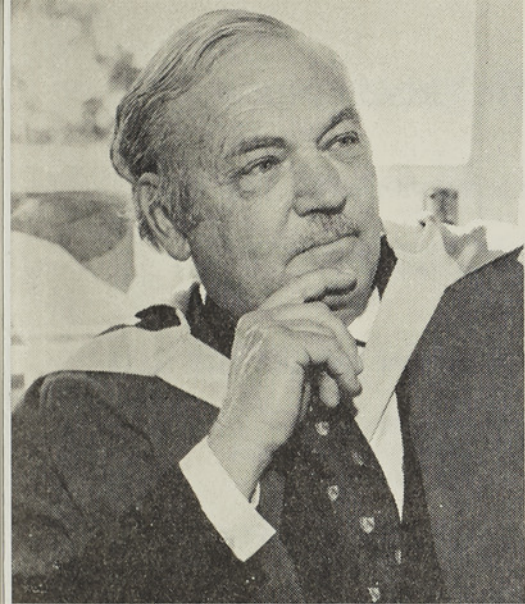

PROFESSOR Noel Desmond Clarence was born in Pietermaritzburg and educated at Maritzburg College. He proceeded to Natal University College, Pietermaritzburg, where he was awarded the Bachelor of Science degree with a first class pass in Physics in 1941. After service in the Special Signal Services for three and a half years, he returned to Natal University College to complete the University Education Diploma in 1945. While holding a Junior Lectureship in the Department of Physics, he completed his thesis and was awarded the Master of Science degree with distinction in 1947; in the same year he was awarded an Elsie Ballot Scholarship which took him to Cambridge for two years, culminating in the award of a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in 1949 followed by the Master of Arts in 1954, he was awarded the Ph.D. degree of this University in 1956. Returning to the Durban campus in 1949, he was appointed as a Lecturer in Physics, followed by promotion to Senior Lecturer in 1956, Professor in 1959 and Head of the Department of Physics in 1968, a post he held until 1973. During his academic career Professor Clarence spent three periods of furlough working in research institutions in South Africa, the United Kingdom and the United States of America, concerned with his field of research — atmospheric and magnetospheric physics. He has served on the Boards of Faculties of Science, Engineering, Medicine and Architecture and as Dean of the Faculty of Science, as well as on numerous committees of the Senate and Council. In the scientific field he has served as Vice-Chairman and Chairman of one of the commissions of the International Scientific Radio Union and is still Scientific Advisor to the Magnetic Observatory at Hermanus. He has attended numerous conferences both local and overseas in his own right as a scientist and as a member of the South African delegation and has published in a number of leading scientific journals. In 1974 he was appointed as Vice-Principal, Durban, and has acted as Principal since Professor Stock's departure in August this year.

PROFESSOR Noel Desmond Clarence word in Pietermaritzburg gebore en ontvang sy skoolopleiding aan die Maritzburg Kollege. Hy studeer verder aan die Natalse Universiteitskollege in Pietermaritzburg en die B.Sc.-graad word in 1941 aan hom toegeken met 'n eersteklasslaagpunt in Fisika. Na $3\frac{1}{2}$ jaar diens in die Spesiale Seindienste keer hy in 1945 terug na sy alma mater en verwerf die Universiteitsonderwysdiploma. Terwyl hy as Junior Lektor in die Departement Fisika werksaam is, voltooi hy sy tesis en verwerf die M.Sc.-graad in 1947 met lof. Gedurende dieselfde jaar word 'n Elsie Ballot-beurs aan hom toegeken waarna hy na Cambridge gaan en in 1949 'n Honneurs B.A.-graad en in 1954 'n M.A.-graad verwerf. Gedurende 1956 word die Ph.D.-graad deur die Universiteit van Natal aan hom toegeken. Hy keer in 1949 terug na die Durban-kampus en word aangestel as Lektor in Fisika. Bevordering tot Senior Lektor volg in 1956 en tot Professor in 1959. In 1968 word hy aangestel as Hoof van die Departement Fisika en dié pos beklee hy tot 1973. In sy akademiese loopbaan het Professor Clarence gedurende drie tydperke van studieverlof in navorsingsinrigtings in Suid-Afrika, die Verenigde Koninkryk en die Verenigde State van Amerika gewerk en was hy veral gemoeid met navorsing op die gebied van atmosferiese en magnetosferiese fisika. Hy het gedien in die fakulteitsrade van Natuurwetenskappe, Ingenieurswese, Medisyne en Argitektuur en was ook Dekaan van die Fakulteit Natuurwetenskappe. Hy het ook in verskeie komitees van die Senaat en die Raad gedien. Op wetenskaplike gebied was hy Vise-Voorsitter en ook Voorsitter van een van die kommissies van die Internasionale Wetenskaplike Radio-unie. Hy is tans nog Wetenskaplike Adviseur vir die Magnetiese Observatorium by Hermanus. Hy het verskeie konferensies beide plaaslik en oorsee bygewoon, in sy eie reg as wetenskaplike en ook as lid van Suid-Afrika se afvaardiging, en van sy artikels het in vooraanstaande wetenskaplike tydskrifte verskyn. In 1974 is hy aangestel as Vise-Prinsipaal in Durban en word waarnemende Prinsipaal toe Professor Stock in Augustus vanjaar vertrek!
