## BRIEF REPORT FROM NOVEMBER 88 TO JANUARY 1989.

- 1. Have been able to negotiate for bigger offices where we are opening a library that would benefit the Norwegian Community. We moved in at Christmas time and have settled down.
- 2. Did tours for two weeks in December on women's issues as funds were from the Women's wing of Fellesrådet in Oslo. I visited a Centre for Development Studies in Bergen and there was interest in having a woman in the centre to do a research on Women in Development.

- 4. We had a very successful January 8th. Famous artists in Norway committed themselves. This was a beautiful occasion and we raised NOK 110.650 (see Statement of Account attached).
- 5. Have started on a new campaign "Schools Against Apartheid". It will be launched on 16th March.
- 6. There is the TV-Campaign. It seems positive that the ANC Women will get this even though there are lots of other groups trying to get this money. We are pushing very hard.
- 7. The children from Mazimbu arrived on 22/1/89. They have started their tour and so far it has been very successful.

Anders Gynnild in Trøndelag and his group have donated a video machine, Track suits etc. to Mazimbu. The group will take with them back.

This Campaign as you will remember I started in May 1988 sponsored by Framfylkingen and it should wind up in May this year. I'm not sure whether they will require someone from HQ to come and close the campaign in order to receive the money, -but will get back to you concerning this in due course.
