CONFERENCE ON DAKAWA

SUBMISSION BY REGIONAL TREASURER

1. A Treasury Administration to be set up here -to operate seperately from Mazimbu. The work of this administration must not be allowed to overlap into joint work with the Mazimbu structure.
2. Seperate Banking accounts to be operated for Dakawa Project:- Local and External Accounts.
All funds for Dakawa to be channelled direct into these accounts.
3. Funding for educational projects, Building Project, Agricultural Projects and small industries to be clearly identified to allow for easier administration of these funds.
4. Projects Team to be established for Dakawa - all Projects proposals to be made to the Projects Team - projects to be well planned and properly co-ordinated.
5. Costs of Electrical installations, roads construction, installation of Telephones, Telex etc. to be worked out along with the costs of the general development plans.
6. For the general implementation of all installations, it is imperative that Dakawa be supplied with sufficient water. As a priority; a water project has to be prepared and the funds sought.

Administration of Dakawa as a whole

It would be an ideal situation if Dakawa could have its own Administration. However, this then will require cadres of certain skills to take up position of responsibility. Are they available? The Administration at Mazimbu is presently stretched beyond its limits. Will it be practical to extend it further to Dakawa.

D.A.P.P. - in so far as funding agencies are concerned, Mazimbu is a model of the ANC administrative capabilities. Therefore the administration at Dakawa must remain purely ANC.

8. Transport for Dakawa

We have to ensure that a carefully thought out transport analysis, based on the final plans for Dakawa, is drawn up. Experience has shown that this item was not accorded proper consideration.

With envisaged plans for Dakawa an able transport fleet will be part of the nerve centre of the project.
