I cannot wait anymore you know Thami, I have to write straight and to the point there is no more time.

You know Thami, I'm facing a problem here. I was supposed to leave the country, Bulgaria last year end of July. I finished my studies (exams) on the 17<sup>th</sup> July and I graduated on the 19<sup>th</sup> July, but I couldn't move because of Levato's ticket.

Prior to that, I wrote letters to our Headquarters in Zambia our Scholarship Department in Tanzania, our Embassy in U.S.A. and recently Germany, Sweden and London without any success. This is almost 8 months. The bad part of it is that we don't even have place to stay, it is really horrible, I'm leading a tough life.

Now Thami please do me a favour, just talk to Phindi, Zandi and Ntuthu and try to organise something. The ticket for here is 600 dollars.

You can send it through the bank. The safest way. Send it to IVY MKIZE P.O. BOX 410 C' (four one-zero central) Varna Bulgaria. They are chasing me and the others out of the country.

Thami please the sooner the better. Here is an example of a copy I received from Germany. Can you send me a phone number where I can contact you, please the earlier the better I get out of this country. Thami please I have no other hope, you are my last resort. Just try by all means Thami, this is no life for me and the kid.

I'm anxiously looking forward for help.

## RE: TICKETS

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 17th February 1991 as refers.

We have a very strict pattern of operation applying now lately, agencies which could be of help in the issuing of tickets only concerntrate on students studying under them and secondly residing in Germany.

I think your case can only be resolved by the Education Department in Lusaka which would have to apply for tickets from donor agencies. From here, any assistance requested in the area of Education or related matters we are demanded to refer the matter to the Education Structure. It has actually been very difficult to do anything from here.

You better also approach the Church in Bulgaria, maybe they can help. I have tried to get assistance for Cds. in Hungary but was unsuccessful because they are outside Germany, I put their case to HQ Jhb Education. I have heard no reply. All I'm saying is that all agencies want to Education signature.
