Dear Rikke Nohrlind

I refer to our letter of 10 November 1994, and your letter of 30 January 1995.

Enclosed is an interim Report on funding for projects of The Batlagae Trust, together with individual reports from certain projects.

As noted in your letter, we are pleased to report on the following areas:

The Bursary Programme

This programme is in its final year of operation. We have fully allocated your funding allocated to bursaries, and enclose details in the attached Interim Report covering the period July 1993 to February 1995. Since some of the payments are still being made during this first quarter of 1995, we will be in a position to provide you with a final report in mid-1995 at the earliest. '

By April 1995, you will receive copies of our 1994 Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements. If possible, we will also provide you with 1995 audited financial statements ' during 1995. However, if these are not complete during 1995, they will reach you early in 1996.

Kangwane Work Study Centre and Khuphuka Step Project

We reported previously (November 1994) on this project, and at the same time enclosed individual reports from KWSC and Khuphuka Step. The Khuphuka Step report covers funding from Nordic Operation Dayswork for 1993/94, and is presented together with a financial statement.

Also enclosed are the audited reports of the Youth Education Trust (for the Kangwane project) for 1993 and 1994.

As the monitoring for these projects was the joint responsibility of the Batlagae Trust and Interfund, there may be a further report provided by Interfund. It may also be the case that the reporting provided so far meets all your requirements in terms of accountability.

Thank you, once again, for your support of our important work. It has helped a significant number of young returnees to gain education and skills which they can in turn use in the development and rebuilding of a liberated and democratic South Africa.
