## Artists' workshop closes

THE United States-South Africa Leadership Exchange Programme (Ussalep) and the Federated Union Of Black Arts (Fuba) are running a workshop for 15 black South African artists.

The 1985 Ussalep/Fuba incentive programme, which started on September 15, ends this week.

The artists are: Ezrom Legae, Fikile Magadela, Avhashoni Manganye, Kenneth Thabe, Garth Erasmus, Peter Clarke, David Magano, Kay Hassan, Rduzani Nemasetoni, Sam Nhlengetwa, Durant Sihlali, Lefika Malope, Kagiso Mautloa, Paul Madi and Philip Malumise.

Work created during the workshop will be exhibited at the Fuba Gallery, Newtown, Johannesburg, from October 6 to October 18.

The workshop is led by Mr Peter Bradley, a graduate of the Society of Arts and Crafts in Detroit and Yale University. He has been artist in residence at Syracuse University and has taught at Franconia College, New Hampshire.

He is presently based in New York City and has held numerous exhibitions both in the United States and Europe. His work forms part of the permanent collection of the Metropolitan Art Museum and many other leading American galleries.
