Dear Comrades,

re: ANC Youth Summer School - August 1980

As a follow up to our letter of the 17th January, 1980, we should like to concretise our request for assistance for transport expenses for our students from Africa, Latin America, Cuba, and North America.

The summer school, which takes place at a time, when the struggles of the youth and people of Southern Africa are on the forward march and have registered tremendous blows against the fascist regimes in this region, and when the African National Congress is commemorating the 25th Anniversary of the Freedom Charter and the birth of SACTU, is bound to be of significant importance in the struggle of our youth for national and social liberation.

It will take place from the 30th July to the 3rd of August 1980 in Budapest. Request for the transportation of about 120 delegates, coming from 22 different countries, Europe, North America, Cuba and Africa, have been made to various national and International organisations of the youth.

We hereby request your organisation to assist in providing 2 tickets for our delegates from the Cuban Unit of our Youth and Students Section, from Havana to Budapest and back. We also request your Union to assist our delegates from Romania, who will be expected to pay for their travel expenses from their own resources, in obtaining visas to and from Romania to Budapest.

Our Youth and Students Section will also welcome a message of solidarity with their struggle for National and Social Liberation.

While appreciating the numerous tasks of the Communist Youth Union of Romania, we hope that your organisation will respond favourably to our request. We further take this opportunity to express our heart-felt gratitude for the solidarity expressed with our youth and people in their just struggle for democracy peace and progress.
