Profile A missionary and physical scientist of the Rhenish Missionary Society. 1841–51 lived in Bethanie, SWA/Namibia, visiting Windhoek on numerous occasions. 1851–53 lived in Tulbagh, Cape Province; 1853 returned to Norway. His work is thought to have been represented in the Archives of the Rhenish Mission at Barmen, Germany.
