MONTHY HOUSING REPORT .

Despite The housing situation is daily detororiating a large number of Cdes joining our working force in the complex, some older members of our community further contribute to this long standing problem. A large number of the Somafco school children stay with their parents instead of boarding. This unhealthy atmosphere is apparently encouraged by most parents in our community. To make matters worse decisions are being taken by seniour officials behind the housing officer's back. How then do we expect the housing officer to be efficient? Peopleare sneaked into houses without the housing officer. To solve this aggravation situation within our community and to ensure smooth running of housing allocation, correctprocedure has to followefrom the top. The slow construction of new Tabora Area also owes to this. however little progress has to an extend being done. Sometime ago during the housing committee meeting, the regional Commissar was entrusted with the task of forming complex commisariat, on the basis of residential areas of which he deed. But up to now, the housing officer has never been introduced to the newly formed complex area commisariat i.e. a formel meeting with them.

UNITS .

Cde Ndumiso is still not yet housed and presentlysquatting at the housing offirer's house. Jerry swapped around with Makhosazane who was formely stating in Unit 2. One of our voluntees Cde Julia has left after her long service and her room is presently occpied by acde Izzy, the teacher. Our office is still not clear about Cde MaAfrica's room. The school ourthorities still have to clearfy the question of his arral.

TABORA.

The question of Girlbert and his partner is still a problem in our dept. They are now accupying two separate room yet we having serious shortage of houses and apparently is condoned by the
