ADMINISTRATION REPORT ON
FIRST PHASE OF COMMUNITY LIAISON PROGRAMME

Introduction

The CA decided from the outset that the process which produces the new Constitution must be a people-driven process. To this end, it has agreed to embark upon a Public Participation Programme (PPP) to give the greatest possible number of South Africans the opportunity of directly participating in the constitution-making process.

The PPP has two major arms : a Community Liaison Programme and a Media Campaign.

The Community Liaison Programme consists of three programmes :

- > Constitutional Public Meetings (CPMâ\200\231s);
- Â» National Sector Hearings; and a
- > Constitutional Education Programme (CEP).

This report is intended to update Management Committee on the First Phase of the Community Liaison Programme which comes to an end at the end of June 1995. There are only three CPMâ\200\231s left for this phase. These will be held in George, Maokeng and Pietermaritzburg on the week-end of 24 June.

CPMâ\200\231s

In terms of the CA mandate, the CPM Programme was oriented towards rural and disadvantaged communities. There have been 22 CPMâ\200\231s to date in all provinces. More than 649 structures of civil society have been consulted in the process and 193 Theme Committee members participated. Each CPM is preceded by a Consultative Meeting. There have been 19

Consultative Briefings in preparation for the CPMâ\200\231s. Annexure A provides a list of organisations consulted.

The CPM programme involved and engaged civil society structures and the public at large in mainly the rural and disadvantaged communities. The public were afforded an opportunity to make submissions, both verbal and written and in doing so were given an opportunity to interface directly with their elected representatives. The programme reached a large number of civil society structures and members of the public who have not historically enjoyed effective access to political processes. The programme facilitated an ownership of the process by involving community structures in the organisation of each of the events.

People in the rural areas were meaningfully consulted in a way which is probably without parallel in South African history. Some form of CPM event should continue to be implemented during the next phase of the Public Participation Programme when a draft Constitution is available for comment and should be extended to include urban areas.

National Sector Public Hearings

In May 1995, the Constitutional Assembly embarked on a series of National Sector Public Hearings.

The objectives we wanted to achieve were part of the overall objective of creating a people-driven process and legitimising the constitution-making process. More specifically, the objectives of the sector hearings were :|

To afford the relevant sectors of society with an opportunity to make their comments and submissions on a new Constitution to members of Theme Committees;

To involve members of Theme Committees in the Public Participation Programme, particularly to hear what the organised sectors's views are on what a new Constitution should look like;

To involve organisations within civil society in a partnership in organising such events.

To date 7 National Sector Public Hearings have been held with approximately 253 organisations participating. Both written and oral submissions were received at all hearings.

Given the extremely limited time the Administration had to develop and implement this programme, the National Public Sector Hearings has been a qualified success. In some instances, it should be mentioned, it was the first in South African history that such broadly representative gatherings were convened of such important sectors as traditional authorities. In short, the successes of the programme are as outlined :

The stated objectives were met;

The consultation process was an extensive one;

Both the Sectors consulted and the Theme Committee members expressed their satisfaction in the usefulness of the process; and The success of the process is also evident in the substantive submissions that were made during the Hearings.

In particular, the National Sector Public Hearings have succeeded in engaging organised sectors of civil society in the constitution-making process and thereby facilitating the participation of the broader public. This is a part of the Public Participation process which we hope to continue in the second phase.

In addition, to National Sector Hearings, a number of other hearings and seminars on specific issues were hosted by individual Theme Committees.

CONSTITUTIONAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME (CEP)

The Constitutional Education Programme has in this first phase concentrated on setting up the necessary infrastructure and training of personnel. It has succeeded in laying a solid basis for work in the next phase. To date, the Administration has appointed two staff members of the Constitutional Education Programme in each province. These staff are accommodated in SACSâ\200\231s regional offices.

The Constitutional Education Programme began its pilot phase on 10 May 1995. Work in this phase has in the main involved supporting the Constitutional Public Meetings by conducting preparatory discussions and workshops in the relevant communities.

During the period 10 May 1995 - 17 June 1995 a total of 100 briefings and 40 workshops have been held. Through these approximately 150 organisations and 9 841 people have been reached.

The CEP programme will underpin the Public Participation Programme during the next phase of CA work when draft text is available for public comment. While the workshop will continue to be the principal face -to- face delivery mechanism of the CEP, other mechanisms will be used to educate people about the draft Constitution, for example, radio and school programmes. During this phase the CEP will need to work closely with structures of civil society to achieve the scope and depth that will be required to educate the broader public on the draft Constitution.

CONCLUSION

The face - to -face component of the Public Participation Programme in the past four - and -a - half months has reached a broad and representative cross-section of South African society. This was made possible in the short time available by consulting with the overwhelming majority of organised

sectors of South African society. Approximately 900 organisations were reached both through the National Sector Public Hearings and through the

CPM\200\231s.

The process of consultation has had a number of additional achievements:

13 Consulting with rural and disadvantaged communities which have hitherto been marginalised in terms of organised political processes.

Ownership of the constitution-making process. Civil society structures were not merely requested to make submissions, but were involved as partners in the process of making submissions. This partnership has served to empower civil society. to assert their own

views.

It is not possible to physically reach 44 million people, but it has been possible to reach those who can reach them. In accessing millions of people through civil society structures, the overall achievement of the Public Participation Programme in this phase has been to begin to create a truly people - driven process. The nature of this process of consultation has added a new dimension to the development of democracy in South Africa. In the next phase this will need to be consolidated and intensified. Having solicited the views of most roleplayers during this phase, the CA is now obliged to refer text back to the public for further comment for two important reasons. The first is to provide the public with a concrete report-back on work done by the CA in this first phase, and the second reason is to solicit further comments on draft text leading up to the finalisation of the new Constitution.

Our success thus far has shown the need for an extended Public Participation Programme in the next phase of CA work. This will obviously have cost implications. A draft programme and budget is being prepared and will shortly be placed before Management Committee for approval. '

These costs will be covered in the September update of the 1995/96 CA Budget.
