LIONEL ABRAHAMS



Lionel Abrahams, South African critic, editor, publisher and writer of fiction and poetry, took the B.A. degree at the University of the Witwatersrand.

During the late 1940's Abrahams attended creative writing classes organised by Herman Charles Bosman and at the time of Bosman's death, Abrahams was granted permission to prepare for publication the then uncollected writing. This project, which has occupied Abrahams intermittently since 1951, has resulted in the appearance of six volumes of Bosman's stories and poems as well as an important critical assessment of the writer's achievement.

In 1957, Abrahams began a literary journal THE PURPLE RENOSTER and some years later founded the 'publishing house' Renoster Books. Launched in 1971 Renoster Books helped into print the first of the 'New Black Poets of the 1970's': OSWALD MTSHALI appeared, under Abrahams's imprint, in SOUNDS OF A COWHIDE DRUM.

Co-recipient in 1976 of a Pringle Award, co-editor (with Nadine Gordimer) of the anthology SOUTH AFRICAN WRITING TODAY (1967), co-editor and guiding spirit of the literary journal QUARRY (1977-79) and co-founder in 1974 of Bateleur Press, Abrahams has also written many critical articles, reviews and introductions to editions, as well as a novel and two books of poems.

The University of Natal honours Lionel Abrahams for the distinguished service he has rendered in the advancement of literature, and literary thought and life, in this country.
