Only' he can explain, why he kept an envelope marked "urgent" for almost two months even when M. Tikly, myself and other were anxiously searching for it. It was handed to NPA by myself on 22/10/92.

NPA insists that they' have been informed by' ANC that no request will be made to cover July/August salaries for six people out of the handover budget.
