GUIDELINES ON HOW TO CONTACT ADULT EDUCATORS IN SOUTH AFRICA.

- 1. Consult with the ANC and PAC
- 2. Papers NO. 6 and 7 as a basis.
- 3. Reference should be made to the WUS report (this will be sent to AALAE Secretariat).
- 4. When contact is made with large groups inside the country,
- e.g. Ikageng, efforts must be made to ensure that smaller
- . groups are also informed.
- 5. The question of fUnding should be considered, e.g. conflicts of interests between a sponsoring agency and the people involved with the work.
- 6. There should be collaboration between WUS and AALAE, as well as between AALAE and Oxfam.
- 7. It is important to be Sensithm to the welfare of adult educators inside the country; e.g. invitations should be very low-key. ,
- . 8. AALAE should expand contacts with the University of the Western Cape (UWC).
- 9. Church related youth groups should be contacted.
- 10. Co-operatives could also be contacted. ANC comrades to explore this.
- 11. The ANC to explore also the possibility of engaging black business groups.
