We however, accepted what we were given in good faith.

The Treasury has now taken possession of these uniforms and materials. I would like to suggest that seeing that another National day is due shortly, the committee submit a requisition for uniforms in good time to the tailoring department, to afford thg, tailoring xx) department enough time to make uniforms for the women and if possible for all the women in Morogoroznazinbu.

I would like to bring to the attention of the committee that in as much as it is a fact that the black and green material is for Women's uniforms, this in no way entitles any member of the Womenis 7% Seetien to obtain material without the aproval of the Treasury.

In that case all requisitions for material by thaWomen's Section must be processed through the normal channels.
