**CIRCULAR TO ALL ANC MISSIONS**

**RE: SOMAFECO 10TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS**

You are hereby informed that the preparations for the SOMAFECO 10th Anniversary celebration are underway and proceeding without impediment.

Please be advised that the plans for the celebration are as follows:-

1. The celebrations are scheduled to last for a period of five days from the 21st to the 25th August, 1989.
2. The celebrations, during the first two days, the 21st and 22nd August will be in the form of a Seminar under the subject theme "People's Education for People's Power!".
3. The seminar will be an In-house ANC seminar in which ANC educationists will participate and also educationists from the Mass Democratic Movement inside South Africa.
4. The climax of the celebrations will be on Wednesday the 23rd August - International Day - to which friends and supporters of the struggle of the people of South Africa are invited and also activists in the struggle from inside South Africa. (Programme enclosed)
5. The fourth and fifth day the 24th and the 25th August, will be days in which opportunity is given to the membership of our movement to participate directly in the celebrations through cultural performances, poetry recitals and a variety of other forms of collective celebration.
6. ANC missions are advised that it has been decided by the leadership of our movement that all friends and supporters of the ANC in their regions are permitted to

send representatives to the International day.

7. Organisations that wish to send representatives should be informed that they will be expected to meet the costs and expenses of their representatives in respect of Air-Fares, Hotel accommodation costs, airport tax and all other expenses relating to travel to and from SOMAFSCO.


8. All other costs relating to the International Day itself will be borne by the ANC.

9. There is no limit to the number of representatives organisations may wish to send to the celebrations.

10. All Chief Representatives wishing to attend the SOMAFSCO 10th Anniversary celebrations are required to organise and raise their own Air-tickets to enable them to attend.

It is important that organisations wishing to send representatives inform the Education Department through the office of the ANC Chief Representative in the region where they are, or communicate their intention and the name of their representative to the Education Department. This is to enable the SOMAFSCO 10th Anniversary Preparatory and Reception Committee to make arrangements for the appropriate and proper reception of all arriving guests for the occasion.
