PHILLIP ALEXANDER CLANCEY

PHILLIP ALEXANDER CLANCEY
was born and educated in the Glasgow
area of Scotland. He began his career
as an ornithologist very early in life.
His professional career in that field
was however delayed first by War
service â\200\224 from 1939 till the end of
1945 â\200\224 mainly in the Sicilian and
Italian sector, in the 5th Survey Regi-
ment, and then by a dearth of suitable
museum openings in the immediate
post-war world.

It was the famous explorer and writer,
Col. Richard Meinertzhagen who first
gave Clancey his chance, by inviting
him to join an expedition to Arabia
and Africa in 1948. With that inval-
uable experience behind him, he
entered the museum profession in
1949, at Scarborough.

Happily for this country and this
province, Clancey accepted the / i
curatorship of the Natal Museum in 1950, and in 1952 he transfferred to Durban as
Director of our Museum and Art Gallery. There he has built up the museumâ\200\231s
collection of birds virtuailly from scratch, to approximately 33 500 â\200\224 most of them
skinned, prepared and mounted by himself. The painted backgrounds which are such a
well known feature of the bird display cases, are largely Clanceyâ\200\231s own work â\200
\224 as
indeed are many of the display cases themselves. In addition, not a year seems to have
passed without an expedition somewhere in Africa, to collect more specimens.

Clanceyâ\200\231s list of publications is prodigious. Even if one omits his more youthful
achievements and begins with his publication at the age of 19, â\200\234The description of
a new
race of Wrenâ\200\235, he has well over 400 papers to his name, most of them under his sole
authorship. His books on birds, with their wonderful illustrations, are known and
admired throughout the world of bird lovers; indeed it may be said that his work is
appreciated more overseas than it is in South Africa. Nevertheless, he has already been
honoured in this country with the Presidency of the South African Museums
Association and of the South African Ornithological Society, of which body he is an
Honorary Life Member. In 1973 the Society awarded him its Gill Memorial Medal, for
services to African Ornithology. His overseas honours include the Fellowship of the
Museums Association, London, and he is Corresponding Fellow of the American
Ornithologists Union.

As Director of the Durban Museum and Art Gallery for 30 years, Clanceyâ\200\231s
responsibilities and contributions have of course not been confined to the field of
ornithology, in which he has so distinguished himself as a scientist. He has guided,
administered and developed an important cultural centre in our midst, with a sure
hand, if not without controversy. In spite of perennial lack of funds, Clancey has made
the domain over which he presides one of which Durban may be justifiably proud.

The University is proud therefore to honour Phillip Alexander Clancey not only for his
outstanding and widely acclaimed contributions to African ornithology, but also for
his untiring, and largely unrecognised, services to fellow-scientists and the whole
Durban community, and as guardian of so much of Durbanâ\200\231s scientific and cultural
heritage.
