

## RE: REMOVAL OF SHORTY FREEDOM FROM HARARE

We have had considerable consultation and correspondence regarding this matter and it has been agreed between DAC, OTG and the Harare that Cde Shorty Freedom should be removed from Harare. In our last discussions with Cde Mabizela he said he was awaiting final go ahead from Cde T-G.

During the SIDA talks, Tor Sellstrom and I had occassion to discuss the problems of the P.A. System with Cde T-G, who very categorically said that Cde Shorty should be removed now. In response to a request that he notify the Harare Office he said it was DAC's decision to place him there and that we had the jurisdicition to remove him.

Consequently we are writing to you to request your assistance in ensuring that Cde Shorty is to be sent to Tanzania. He may well feel he should return to Amandla, but they have made it clear they do not want him to rejoin the group.

Cde Max, please act on this matter so that this long overdue problem can be dealt with. Meanwhile we have long requested the RCC to look into the matter of contracting the P.A. System out to a professional group and are still awaiting a contract, prior to signing, for DCLA to vet and approve. Your assistance and push in this matter would be greatly appreciated.

We enclose copy of letter to the Deputy Chief Rep in Harare, which speaks for itself.


His removal from Harare has been raised for the past year or longer by numerous persons, including the Chief Rep and Regional Treasurer, out of concern and criticism over the handling of the P.A. System. It was to oversee and maintain the P.A. System that he was initially requested to base there, but he has proved not to look after the system adequately, which has had to be repaired by overseas experts at great cost to the movement. More importantly it is, in fact, the opinion of many that he has abused his position for personal financial gain and he has never properly accounted to the Regional Treasurer for money earned through hiring of the system.

Cde T-G ascertained that DAC should go ahead in seeing to the removal of Shorty, stating that we had the jurisdiction to do so. Consequently we have requested that Cde Max Mlonyeni see to this. We hope that this action in no way counters the authority and approval of your good office, but his removal has long been delayed awaiting formal direction from the leadership.
