
We would very much appreciate the participation of three comrades (including yourself) - one in each of the following subjects: Basic English, Mathematics and Agriculture.

Dear Comrade Stan,

It was a great pleasure for Dr. Chale and me to meet and exchange views with you and Comrade George Twala yesterday afternoon. Thank you very much indeed for granting us an appointment at such short notice.

You will recall that we discussed the telex which I had sent on 30 May to SOMAFCO, which concerned a number of issues including our proposed visit to Morogoro from 19 to 22 June 1986. For ease of reference, I attach a photocopy of that telex.

I note from your letter of 3 June to Dr. Chale that, in the current circumstances, it would not be practicable for us to visit Mazimbu and Dakawa. However, you indicated during our discussion yesterday that those who are involved in the SAEU's work at the settlement would be able to visit us at Morogoro Hotel on the above mentioned dates, in order to discuss the current operation and future development of the project.

As we agreed, we look forward to the pleasure of the company to dinner at Morogoro Hotel at 7 pm on Thursday 19 June of 3 or 4 of the ANC's senior officials at the settlements who are most closely involved with the project. We could also discuss on that occasion items D and E in my telex of 30 May. We would hope on 20 and 21 June to meet the tutors, group leaders and others who are responsible for the day to-day arrangements for the groups of Comrades who are pursuing the Unit's courses at Mazimbu and Dakawa.
