The chair opened the meeting by apologising for delay in a meeting which was supposed to be held on the 15.4.88 because Mr Mahai was not present with the necessary documents hence the delay. He expressed the desire of the Ministry's Selection Committee to visit our Educational centres eg Kwanza Sul (Swapo) and Moses KOTANE to evaluate our educational programmes. The chair also stressed that the names of applicants appearing in their application forms should be the same as those in their travelling documents otherwise they will be taken as not the same person. He also stressed that the students should be informed about the courses on which the Selection committee has placed them so that in case the candidate is not interested in a course this information should be communicated to the UNDP immediately, so that the space could be utilised. All students are expected to report on the 15.7.88 at the orientation centre at Kibaha here in Tanzania, failure to which they won't be accepted.

Methods of Selection

Senior course...Requirements...O Levels or equivalent eg -
S T D IO with Maths, Biology, Physics with at least 3 credits

Junior Course

This courses are given to candidates who are below O Levels as a step ladder to doing senior courses- eg Rural Medical Aid as a step to doing Medical Assistant.

Selection of A N C Applicants

Out of 24 candidates, 21 were accepted. From the six cdes who were suspended in 1986 3 were rejected-They are:

-Mathe Edward Ponkie

-Reasons- It was explained that if a student has been discontinued on disciplinary reasons and the Ministry of Health endorses the discontinuation, in no way can the student be re-admitted in their schools. This is the policy of the Ministry. So the above cde was rejected on those basis as stated above.

-Ngcobo Mbongeni

Reason: He was also discontinued on poor performance and disciplinary reasons and excessive indulgence to alcohol. The above conditions also applies to him.

-Mpethwana Christopher James (Ndlela)

-Reason: The school authorities were highly suspicious of him being a dagga smoker and the fact that he could not account for the dangerous drugs he was found with at the school he was also rejected.

From the new candidates 2 were rejected. Their names are:

-Reason: The Ministry Selection committee were suspicious of his academic background. His curriculum Vitae goes as thus
1. Primary education up to S T D 7 in Elitha primary school
2. Secondary education.. up to Form II at Mozi Ontisundu.

NB. They were mainly worried about the subjects he wrote for a Form II student. Rejected.
