Despite a historical legacy of economic and communications links, under your clear sighted and able leadership Botswana has maintained a principled stand. You have spoken out against racism and apartheid and in favour of the genuine liberation of all of southern Africa. Since June 1976 Botswana has given refuge to our children, and despite border provocations and attacks by Smith and the apartheid army you have remained steadfast in your support for our struggle. The traditional brotherhood between our people has thus been given concrete expression.

Our liberation struggle has received consistent and concrete support from the government and people of Sweden. Opposition to apartheid has been expressed not only in words and resolutions, but in the form of support ~~for~~ and material assistance for the African National Congress. In this past year, the bonds of friendship and solidarity have grown and found new expression. While consistently working for international action, Sweden has unilaterally stopped new investment in the apartheid economy and has established a Commission to investigate methods of eliminating all economic links.

Such actions not only express a genuine solidarity with our struggle, but also serve to encourage and influence other countries to take similar steps. We look to the international community to ensure that 1978

Letter to Prime Minister of India.

Paragraphs 1 and 2b then the following paragraph 3

The Verster regime intends this year to impose yet another new constitution upon the people, with the aim of incorporating the Coloured and Indian minorities as second class allies of the ruling whites in opposition to the African majority. True ~~xxxxixx~~ to their tradition, established by Mahatma Gandhi, Indian South Africans have rejected all the blandishments and bribes of Verster and have continued to stand as they have always done, for justice and equality for all South Africans. For steadfastly maintaining their solidarity with the African ~~xxxxixx~~ people many have been detained, sentenced to long terms of imprisonment, tortured and killed. They have been strengthened, as we are, by the knowledge that they have the full support of the Government and people of India. We are confident that the Government of India would not give its support or lend credibility to any group individual or group that sought special privileges for itself and collaborated with the apartheid regime

The links between the liberation struggle in South Africa and India go back into the last century, and have <sup>since</sup> been sustained . It is India that took the first initiatives to mobilise international ~~of~~ opinion against the racist policies of Pretoria, and India that alone and unilaterally cut off trade and economic links with South Africa. Now, in 1978, the year designated as the year against apartheid, we are in the final stages of cutting off all political, military economic and moral assistance and totally isolating the apartheid regime.

3. In this past year, the United Nations has taken a further~~x~~ step towards achieving the ideals enshrined in the Charter. For the first time in ~~xxx~~ its history mandatory sanctions have been imposed under Chapter 7, albeit that they are as yet limited to the supply of arms. In taking this historic decision the world organisation has finally served notice that persistent flouting of world opinion and the provisions of the Charter can no longer be tolerated. In this momentous achievement your personal contribution and interest has been of part~~ixixix~~icular value.
