UNDER PROJECTS: It was said that the celebration of Valentine's day would take place in the youth Centre hall which will be ~~xxx~~ accordingly decorated. Music will be organised, drinks and cakes will be sold at reasonable prices. Admission of ten shillings was suggested and that concrete programme on games be made. It was said that if the treasury does not meet our financial requisition of approximately 7000sh for drinks the tack shop will be called to sell a certain amount of beer and cold drinks.

The meeting agreed that the selling of A.N.C.-shirt, posters and calendars should be done outside the complex, because of past experience. It was once again stressed that all fund-raising money be handed over to the treasury department.
